

PRORATE

Meaning: Prorate: to divide or allocate an amount proportionally based on a specific time period or quantity.

1. The cost of the subscription will be prorated if you sign up in the middle of the month.
2. To ensure fairness, we decided to prorate the bonus based on the number of months worked.
3. If you move before the lease is up, the landlord will prorate your rent for the days you didn't occupy the apartment.
4. When calculating the charges for a partial service period, we need to prorate the fees accordingly.
5. The company's decision to prorate the annual salary for part-time employees reflects its commitment to equitable compensation.
