

# PROROGATE

*Meaning: To prorogate means to suspend or discontinue a legislative session or assembly for a specified period.*

1. The legislature decided to prorogate the session until the following year.
2. In an unexpected move, the governor chose to prorogate the assembly's meetings after heated debates.
3. The council voted to prorogate their discussions until they could gather more information.
4. It is not uncommon for a parliament to prorogate its proceedings during a national crisis.
5. Her decision to prorogate the negotiations left many stakeholders frustrated and anxious.
