Meaning: A proscriber is a person or authority that formally prohibits or condemns something, often by declaring it illegal or unacceptable.

1. The proscriber of the new regulations emphasized the importance of compliance among all employees.
2. In ancient Rome, a proscriber could wield significant power by declaring individuals as enemies of the state.
3. The proscriber's list was a source of fear, as it marked those who faced exile or worse consequences.
4. As a proscriber, she carefully weighed the ethical implications of her decisions on public health.
5. The role of a proscriber often involves balancing the needs of society with individual rights.
