

PROSCRIPTIVE

Meaning: Proscriptive: imposing restrictions or prohibitions that limit freedom or creativity.

1. The new regulations were seen as overly proscriptive, limiting creativity in the design process.
2. Her proscriptive approach to parenting often led to rebellion from her children.
3. In the debate about free speech, many argued that proscriptive laws stifle individual expression.
