

PROTUBERANCE

Meaning: Protuberance: a bulging or projecting part on a surface, often noticeable and distinct in shape or texture.

1. The protuberance on the surface of the rock caught her attention as she examined its unique texture.
2. During the medical examination, the doctor noted a protuberance on the patient's abdomen that warranted further investigation.
3. The geologist explained that the protuberance formed over thousands of years due to the erosion of surrounding material.
