1. The meeting was provisionally scheduled for next Thursday, pending confirmation from all participants.
2. She was provisionally accepted into the program, with the final decision dependent on her upcoming interview.
3. The committee provisionally approved the budget, allowing for further review before finalization.
4. He was provisionally assigned to the project team, subject to reassessment of his workload.
5. The event will be provisionally held outdoors, but a backup indoor venue is reserved in case of rain.
