

PROXIMALLY

Meaning: Proximally: in a position or direction closer to the point of attachment or origin, especially in anatomical contexts.

1. The blood flow to the heart is primarily directed proximally through the major arteries.
2. In anatomical terms, the elbow joint is located proximally to the wrist joint.
3. The surgeon made an incision proximally to ensure better access to the affected area.
4. In a typical mammal, the shoulder joint is found proximally relative to the forelimb.
5. The research focused on the effects of exercise on muscle tissue, particularly proximally near the origin of the muscle.
