*Meaning: Proxy: an intermediary or substitute that acts on behalf of another, often used to access restricted resources or to perform actions like voting.*

1. The company used a proxy to access restricted websites during work hours.
2. In a legal context, she signed a proxy allowing her friend to vote on her behalf.
3. He set up a proxy server to enhance his online privacy and security.
4. The scientist used a proxy measure to estimate the effects of temperature on plant growth.
5. During the meeting, he acted as a proxy for his colleague who was unable to attend.
6. A proxy can act on behalf of someone else in legal matters.
7. The company used a proxy server to enhance its online security.
