

PSEUDOSCOPIC

Meaning: PSEUDOSCOPIC (adjective): relating to a visual effect that creates the illusion of depth or three-dimensionality in a two-dimensional image.

1. The artist's use of light and shadow created a pseudoscopic effect, making the two-dimensional painting appear three-dimensional.
2. In the lecture on optical illusions, the professor explained the concept of pseudoscopic perception and its impact on visual arts.
3. Pseudoscopic images can trick the mind into seeing depth where none exists, challenging our understanding of perspective.
