

# PUMICED

*Meaning: PUMICED (verb): To smooth or abrade a surface using pumice, or to describe a landscape covered with pumice rock, which is a light, porous volcanic material.*

1. The artist pumiced the canvas to create a smooth surface before applying the paint.
2. After the volcanic eruption, the landscape was covered in pumiced rock, giving it an otherworldly appearance.
3. She pumiced her feet to remove the rough skin and keep them soft for summer.
4. The sculptor used pumiced stone to achieve the delicate details of the statue.
5. In her skincare routine, she included a pumiced scrub to exfoliate her skin gently.
