Meaning: Puncheon: a large cask or barrel used for aging wine or spirits, typically holding between 100 to 140 gallons.

1. The winemaker carefully transferred the vintage into a large puncheon to enhance its flavor profile.
2. During the tour of the distillery, we learned how a puncheon can influence the aging process of whiskey.
3. Craft brewers often prefer to use puncheons for their ability to impart unique characteristics to the beer.
