

# PUNCTUM

*Meaning: Punctum refers to a striking detail in an artwork or photograph that evokes a personal emotional response from the viewer.*

1. The artist's use of light created a punctum that drew the viewer's eye to the center of the painting.
2. In photography, the punctum represents the detail that strikes a personal chord with the observer.
