

# PUNISH

*Meaning: To impose a penalty or consequence on someone for wrongdoing or misconduct.*

1. The teacher decided to punish the student for repeated tardiness.
2. Parents often struggle with the decision to punish their children for bad behavior.
3. In some cultures, it is common to punish wrongdoing with community service.
4. He felt it was unfair to punish the entire team for one player's mistake.
5. The judge chose to punish the offender with a hefty fine rather than jail time.
