Meaning: PUNITORY: relating to or intended as punishment or penalization.

1. The judge imposed a punitory fine on the corporation for its reckless environmental practices.
2. In an effort to deter future offenses, the new policy included several punitory measures for repeat offenders.
3. Her supervisor's punitory actions left the team feeling demoralized and unappreciated.
4. The committee debated whether the proposed changes were necessary or simply punitory in nature.
