Meaning: Purre: (verb) to produce a soft, continuous, vibrating sound, typically associated with contentment in cats or a smooth, rhythmic operation in machinery.

3. She felt a sense of comfort when the soft music began to purre in the background.
4. The old car's engine would purre like a kitten when it was well tuned.
