Meaning: To postulate means to suggest or assume the existence, fact, or truth of something as a basis for reasoning or discussion.

1. Scientists often postulate theories based on limited evidence, leading to further research and discovery.

3. The philosopher began to postulate fundamental questions about existence and the nature of reality.
4. It is common to postulate that higher education correlates with increased income, although exceptions exist.
