

# PYGOSTYLE

*Meaning: Pygostyle: a bony structure formed by the fusion of several vertebrae at the posterior end of a bird's skeleton, supporting the tail feathers.*

1. The pygostyle is a fusion of several vertebrae that supports the tail feathers in birds.
2. In paleontology, the pygostyle is an important feature for identifying certain species of dinosaurs.
3. A well-developed pygostyle enables birds to have greater control over their flight maneuvers.
4. Researchers found that variations in the pygostyle structure can indicate behavioral adaptations in avian species.
5. The pygostyle serves as an attachment point for muscles that control tail movements in modern birds.

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
