

QUINCUNCIALLY

Meaning: Quincuncially refers to an arrangement in the shape of a cross or in a pattern of five points, with four points forming a square or rectangle and the fifth point at the center.

1. The garden was arranged quincuncially, creating a visually striking pattern of symmetry.
2. In ancient architecture, columns were often placed quincuncially to enhance the overall aesthetic appeal.
3. The artist chose to position the elements of her painting quincuncially, drawing the viewer's eye across the canvas.
4. For the experiment, the plants were planted quincuncially to maximize sunlight exposure and growth.
5. The seating was organized quincuncially in the auditorium, ensuring each audience member had a clear view of the stage.
