

# QUORUM

*Meaning: Quorum: the minimum number of members required to be present in a group or organization to conduct valid business or make decisions.*

1. A quorum was reached when the majority of board members arrived for the meeting.
2. Without a quorum, the committee could not proceed with voting on the proposed changes.
3. The organization requires at least ten members to form a quorum for any official decision.
4. In the absence of a quorum, the assembly decided to adjourn until the following week.
5. She was relieved when the final member arrived, ensuring that they had a quorum to start the discussion.
