1. Radium was discovered in 1898 by Marie Curie and her husband, Pierre Curie.
2. The use of radium in early cancer treatments was revolutionary, yet it posed significant health risks.
3. Due to its radioactivity, radium must be handled with extreme caution in scientific research.
4. In the early 20th century, radium-infused products were marketed for their supposed health benefits.
5. Radium decays into radon, a colorless and odorless gas that can accumulate in homes.
