

RALLENTANDO

Meaning: Rallentando is a musical term indicating a gradual decrease in tempo.

1. The conductor signaled a rallentando, allowing the musicians to gradually slow down the tempo.
2. As the performance reached its climax, the lead violinist played with a beautiful rallentando that captivated the audience.
3. In the final movement, the composer wrote a rallentando to evoke a sense of melancholy.
