

RANCID

Meaning: Rancid refers to a strong, unpleasant smell or taste resulting from the decomposition or spoilage of fats or oils, often associated with food that is no longer safe to consume.

1. The rancid smell of the spoiled milk filled the entire kitchen.
2. After weeks of neglect, the leftovers in the fridge had turned rancid and were no longer safe to eat.
3. She could tell that the butter was rancid just by taking a whiff of the container.
4. His rancid attitude during the meeting put everyone in a bad mood.
5. The rancid oil was a clear sign that it had been used far beyond its expiration date.
