Meaning: RAPPED: past tense of rap; to strike or tap sharply and lightly (as in making a sound) or to perform a style of music characterized by rhythmic spoken delivery.

1. She rapped her fingers lightly on the table, trying to get his attention.
2. The artist rapped about social issues, resonating with the struggles of his community.
3. He rapped his knuckles against the door, eager to share the good news.
4. As the music played, she rapped along, her enthusiasm infectious.

6. He rapped on the door, eager to enter the party.
7. The artist rapped about his struggles and triumphs in life.
8. She rapped her fingers on the table, waiting for a response.
