

RATHER

Meaning: 'RATHER' is an adverb used to indicate a preference for one option over another or to express a degree of intensity or extent.

1. I would rather stay home tonight than go to that party.
2. She found the book rather boring, despite the glowing reviews.
3. He seemed rather pleased with himself after finishing the project ahead of schedule.
4. It's rather unusual for the weather to be this warm in October.
5. I would rather have tea than coffee in the morning.
6. I would rather stay in tonight than go out to the party.
7. She is rather fond of classical music, especially Beethoven.
8. It was rather surprising to see them at the event after all this time.
9. He would rather read a good book than watch television.
10. The weather was rather chilly for a summer day.
