Meaning: To ratify means to formally approve or confirm a treaty, agreement, or decision, making it officially valid.

1. The government must ratify the treaty before it can take effect.
2. Activists are urging lawmakers to ratify the new climate agreement.
3. Once the amendments are drafted, they will be sent to the states for ratification.
4. The organization was pleased to see a majority of members vote to ratify the proposal.
5. Ratifying the constitution was a significant step in the formation of the nation.
