*Meaning: To rationalize means to attempt to justify or explain one's actions or decisions with logical reasoning, often to make them seem more acceptable or reasonable.*

1. She tried to rationalize her decision to leave the job by focusing on the benefits of pursuing her passion.

3. In an attempt to rationalize his behavior, he cited stress as the main factor influencing his actions.
