Meaning: RATTLINGS: plural noun referring to the series of short, sharp sounds produced by objects moving or shaking against each other, often indicating disturbance or movement.

1. The rattlings of the old pipes echoed through the empty house.

3. In the distance, the rattlings of the train wheels on the tracks signaled its arrival.
4. She listened intently to the rattlings of the wind chimes in the garden.
5. The rattlings of the cage indicated that the bird was restless and eager to fly.
