Meaning: Razed: destroyed completely, typically by demolition or fire.

1. The old factory was razed to make way for a new shopping center.
2. After the fire, the historic building was completely razed, leaving only ashes behind.
3. The city council voted to have the abandoned houses razed for safety reasons.
4. In a matter of minutes, the demolition crew razed the dilapidated structure to the ground.
5. The once vibrant neighborhood was razed, replaced by a sprawling parking lot.
