

RE-FERMENT

Meaning: Re-ferment (verb): to initiate a second fermentation process in a beverage, such as wine or beer, to improve or alter its flavor characteristics.

1. The winemaker decided to re-ferment the batch to enhance the flavor profile.
2. After the initial fermentation, the brewer chose to re-ferment the beer for a more robust taste.
3. If the sugar content in the cider is too high, it may re-ferment unexpectedly in the bottle.
4. To achieve a unique sparkling wine, the process required the grapes to re-ferment in the bottle.
5. Craft brewers often experiment with re-fermenting their products to create innovative flavors.

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
