Meaning: Re-sound: to echo or resonate again, particularly in a way that recalls or amplifies previous sounds or memories.

1. The echoes of the choir began to re-sound in the vast cathedral.

3. After the storm, the music from the radio would re-sound throughout the empty room.
4. The artist aimed to re-sound the themes of love and loss in her new album.
5. With each passing car, the sound of the city would re-sound like a familiar melody.
