

READJOURNMENT

Meaning: Readjournalment refers to the act of postponing or rescheduling a meeting or hearing to a later time or date.

1. The judge announced a readjournalment of the hearing to allow both parties more time to prepare their arguments.
2. Due to unforeseen circumstances, the council's meeting faced a readjournalment until next week.
3. The readjournalment provided the committee an opportunity to gather additional data before making a decision.
4. After the unexpected delay, the board voted for a readjournalment to ensure all members could participate.
5. The readjournalment was met with mixed reactions from the attendees, some relieved and others frustrated.
