Meaning: Readopt: to officially accept or endorse something again, particularly a previous policy, statement, or practice.

1. The organization decided to readopt its original mission statement after realizing it resonated better with their community.
2. After a lengthy discussion, the committee voted to readopt the previous policy on employee benefits.
3. In light of recent changes, the school board chose to readopt the curriculum guidelines from five years ago.
4. The nonprofit aimed to readopt its former strategy to improve outreach and fundraising efforts.
5. To ensure consistency, the team will readopt the branding guidelines established by their predecessor.
