

# REAMPUTATION

*Meaning: Reamputation is the surgical procedure of amputating a limb or part of a limb again after a previous amputation has failed.*

1. Reamputation can often be a necessary procedure in complex surgical cases where previous amputations have failed.
2. The surgeon explained that reamputation might be the only option left to ensure the patient's long-term health.
3. After a thorough examination, the medical team concluded that reamputation was unavoidable due to the extent of infection.
4. Reamputation carries significant risks, but in some cases, it is the best way to restore functionality.
5. Patients facing reamputation often require extensive counseling to cope with the emotional challenges that accompany such decisions.
