

REBELLOW

Meaning: To rebellow means to shout or express oneself loudly and passionately again, often in response to a stimulus or to reinforce a previous statement.

1. The cat decided to rebellow after being startled by the loud noise outside.
2. During the debate, she began to rebellow her earlier points with even more passion.
3. After a moment of silence, the crowd began to rebellow their support for the speaker.
4. He was so frustrated that he chose to rebellow his complaints to anyone who would listen.
5. As the music faded, the audience started to rebellow their favorite song, creating a joyful atmosphere.
