

REBOIL

Meaning: Reboil (verb): to bring a liquid, such as water or broth, to a boil again after it has cooled.

1. You may need to reboil the water if it has cooled down too much.
2. To enhance the flavor, it's best to reboil the broth after letting it sit overnight.
3. If the soup isn't hot enough, you can easily reboil it on the stove.
4. After letting the tea steep, I decided to reboil it for a stronger taste.
5. It's important to reboil the syrup to achieve the right consistency for the candy.
