Meaning: In a manner that expresses sharp disapproval or criticism.

1. She spoke rebukingly, her tone sharp enough to silence the room.
2. His rebukingly raised eyebrow made it clear he disapproved of the suggestion.
3. The teacher looked at the student rebukingly after they interrupted the lesson.
4. With a rebukingly tone, she reminded him of the rules they had agreed upon.
5. He responded rebukingly, clearly frustrated by the persistent mistakes.
