Meaning: To recast means to assign a new actor to a role or to revise and adapt a part of a work, such as a script or narrative.

1. The director decided to recast the lead role after the initial actor withdrew from the project.
2. In an effort to improve the story, the author chose to recast the ending of the novel entirely.
3. The company plans to recast its marketing strategy to better appeal to younger consumers.
4. After receiving feedback, she decided to recast her presentation to make it more engaging for the audience.
5. To fit the new theme of the event, they had to recast the entire lineup of speakers and performers.
