

RECIDIVOUS

Meaning: Recidivous refers to the tendency of a person, particularly a criminal, to relapse into previous undesirable or criminal behavior after having undergone rehabilitation or punishment.

1. The judge expressed concern about the recidivous behavior of the defendant despite numerous rehabilitation efforts.
2. In dealing with recidivous offenders, the justice system often finds itself caught in a cycle of punishment and release.
