Meaning: Recission refers to the act of formally canceling or voiding a contract or decision.

2. The committee decided on a recission of the previous decision after reviewing new evidence.
3. Her careful analysis led to a recission of the initial report, clarifying several key points.
4. The recission of the law sparked a heated debate among the community members.
5. After much deliberation, the board announced the recission of the policy that had been in place for years.
