Meaning: To close something again or to fasten it shut after it has been opened.

1. Please remember to reclose the door after you leave to keep the heat in.
2. After reviewing the document, she decided to reclose it for further edits.
3. The technician had to reclose the panel after fixing the wiring issue.
4. He paused to reclose the lid on the jar to prevent the cookies from going stale.
5. If the conversation drifts, don't be afraid to reclose the topic and steer it back on track.
