

RECLUDE

Meaning: Reclude (verb): to withdraw or remove oneself from participation or involvement in a situation or conversation.

1. Reclude from the conversation if it makes you uncomfortable.
2. He decided to reclude himself from social gatherings to focus on his writing.
3. The committee voted to reclude any members with conflicts of interest.
4. To maintain a peaceful environment, they chose to reclude the loud music after midnight.
5. She felt it was necessary to reclude herself from the toxic influences in her life.
