

RECOGNIZANCE

Meaning: Recognizance is a legal obligation or promise made by a defendant to appear in court at a specified time, often without posting bail.

1. The judge released him on his own recognizance, trusting he would return for the trial.
2. She signed a document pledging her recognizance, promising to appear in court as required.
3. Being placed on recognizance allowed him to stay out of jail while awaiting sentencing.
4. In some cases, defendants can be granted recognizance instead of bail if they pose no flight risk.
5. Her commitment to attending all court dates was formalized through a recognizance agreement.
