Meaning: Recommission (verb): to officially restore or reactivate a facility or service for use after it has been closed or inactive.

1. The company decided to recommission the old factory to meet the increasing demand for their products.
2. After extensive renovations, the city plans to recommission the historic theater by the end of the year.
3. The government announced plans to recommission several decommissioned naval vessels for research purposes.
4. To improve efficiency, the team will recommission the software system with updated features and security protocols.
5. The organization sought to recommission the community center as a hub for local events and gatherings.
