

RECOMPACT

Meaning: Recomcompact: to compact again or to increase the density of a material, such as soil or layers, to restore stability or strength.

1. The construction team had to recomcompact the soil after heavy rains compromised its stability.
2. To ensure the longevity of the pavement, they decided to recomcompact the layers before applying the asphalt.
3. After the excavation was completed, the engineers recommended that we recomcompact the area to prevent future settling.
4. Recompressing the gravel base was essential for supporting the weight of the new structure being built.
5. Once the materials were delivered, the workers began the process to recomcompact the foundation for optimal strength.
