Meaning: Recompile: to compile (software) again from source code, typically after making modifications or updates.

1. To implement the latest features, we need to recompile the software from the source code.
2. After modifying the program, it's essential to recompile it to ensure that the changes take effect.
3. The developer decided to recompile the library to improve its performance and fix existing bugs.
4. Before deploying the update, don't forget to recompile the application to include all the new settings.
5. If you encounter any errors, try to recompile the project to see if that resolves the issue.
