

RECONDENSE

Meaning: Recondense: to change from a vapor back into a liquid state, typically as a result of cooling.

1. As the vapor cooled, it began to recondense into droplets on the surface of the glass.
2. The scientist observed how the steam would recondense when it met the cold metal.
3. In the experiment, the gas was allowed to recondense into a liquid under controlled conditions.
4. To improve efficiency, the system was designed to capture and recondense the exhaust vapor.
5. During the distillation process, the alcohol will recondense and separate from the water.
