Meaning: Recopy (verb): to make a new copy of a document or text, typically to correct errors or ensure completeness.

1. Please recopy the document to ensure that all the information is accurate.
2. She had to recopy the entire chapter after realizing she had missed a crucial section.
3. To avoid confusion, it's best to recopy the notes before the exam.
4. I asked him to recopy the report with the latest data included.
5. After the first draft was deemed unsatisfactory, the editor decided to recopy it with revisions.
