

RECOURSE

Meaning: Recourse refers to the act of seeking help or a solution, typically through a formal process or legal means, in response to a problem or dispute.

1. In the event of a dispute, the parties may seek recourse through arbitration.
2. The victims of the fraud found little recourse in the legal system.
3. After exhausting all other options, she finally turned to her insurance for recourse.
4. His only recourse was to appeal the decision made by the lower court.
5. They felt a deep sense of injustice but saw no recourse available to them.
6. In the event of a dispute, we have no recourse but to seek legal counsel.
7. The company offered a refund as recourse for the defective product.
