

RECRUDESCENT

Meaning: Recrudescence: experiencing a revival or reappearance, especially of something undesirable, such as tensions or violence.

1. The recrudescence tensions between the two countries threatened to ignite a new conflict.
2. After a period of relative peace, the recrudescence violence in the region raised concerns among human rights organizations.
3. The patient's symptoms were recrudescence, indicating that the illness had returned after a brief remission.
4. Despite initial hopes for a resolution, the recrudescence disputes among the factions have stalled progress.
5. Her recrudescence enthusiasm for painting inspired her to take up the brush after years of neglecting her art.
