

RECTIROSTRAL

Meaning: Rectirostral refers to a beak shape that is straight and slender, adapted for efficiently extracting food from narrow spaces.

1. The rectirostral shape of the bird's beak allows it to efficiently extract insects from crevices.
2. In comparative anatomy, the rectirostral feature is particularly notable among certain species of shorebirds.
3. Researchers observed that the rectirostral design of the fish's mouth aids in its feeding strategy.
4. Many ornithologists classify the species as rectirostral due to its straight, pointed bill.
5. The rectirostral adaptations of the animal are key to its survival in its specific ecological niche.
